## For existing students admitted in AY2023

Existing 3-year *Higher Nitec* students who were admitted in AY2023 intake, and are <u>not</u> under the accelerated pathway, will be charged *Higher Nitec* course fees for final Year 3 (i.e. AY2025 Apr intake *Higher Nitec* course fee).

## Note

- 1) The above training fees apply to existing students admitted to 3-year Higher Nitec courses in the AY2023 intake and are not under accelerated pathway
- 2) Fees are charged based on a 6-month period (otherwise known as a "term").
- 3) Fees are inclusive of GST or after GST subsidy.
- 4) Students are required to pay their term fees for all terms by the stipulated dates in order to remain in their course of study. For subsequent terms, students are required to pay their fees through Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA) or GIRO (if you are not paying using PSEA, or your PSEA balance is insufficient for all terms in the course of study).
- 5) Full-time International Students studying in ITE are required to participate in the Group Hospitalisation and Surgical Insurance (International Student) [GHSI(IS)] scheme, and insurance premiums will be included in the fees at the start of each academic term. The purpose of the GHSI(IS) is to help defray hospitalisation expenses for International Students in the event that they are hospitalised. The GHSI(IS) amount payable is subject to yearly review.
- 6) Fees are charged based on their citizenship/residency status at the point of term commencement. Students who have officially informed ITE of a change in their citizenship/residency status, to Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident, before term commencement will have their fees adjusted to the Singapore Citizen/Singapore Permanent Resident rates for that term. Students who inform ITE officially of a change in their citizenship/residency status after term commencement will only have their fees adjusted to the Singapore Citizen/Singapore Permanent Resident rates from the next term.
