
GUIDE FOR REGISTRATION AT COLLEGES

3-YEAR HIGHER NITEC & NITEC COURSES

BEFORE REPORTING TO COLLEGE

1. ACCEPT COURSE OFFER ONLINE

 Log in to https://istudent.ite.edu.sg ('Self-Service' > 'Student Admission' > 'View Application Results')





3. PAY 1ST TERM FEES

- You are required to make fee payment regardless of your bursary/financial assistance outcome
- Refer to application schedule for payment deadline

2. APPLY FOR ITE STUDENT CONCESSION CARD

- Log in to https://myportal.ite.edu.sg/regsubmission
- Use your NRIC/FIN and password used for course acceptance to log in, 2 working days after you have accepted your course offer

4. APPLY FOR BURSARY/FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE **ONLINE (IF ELIGIBLE*)**

- Log in to https://myportal.ite.edu.sg/regsubmission
- Use your NRIC/ FIN and password used for course acceptance to log in, 2 working days after you have accepted your course offer

5. APPLY FOR STUDENT PASS (FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)

- · Apply for Student Pass at https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/esvclandingpage/solarplus, if you do not have a valid immigration pass (e.g. dependent's pass /long-term visit pass)
- · Refer to enrolment letter for more details



REPORTING TO COLLEGE: WHAT TO BRING

1.YOUR IDENTITY CARD (NRIC/FIN)



2.YOUR ITE LOGIN PASSWORD

Password used for course acceptance



3. FEE PAYMENT ITEMS (if applicable)

- NETS/ Credit Card if you have not paid 1st term fees via e-payment or via PSEA SO
- · Application form for Interbank GIRO for subsequent terms if you are not paying via PSEA SO
- Refer to https://www.ite.edu.sg/admissions/full-time-courses/fee- instructions for information on fee payment. If you have paid via online payment, bring your payment receipts when you report to College for verification.



4. PAY FOR UNIFORM PURCHASE

- Pay for uniform which will cost about \$30-\$50 for 1 set (including 1 piece of PE T-shirt)
- Payable by PayNow/Cash/NTUC eVoucher (for selected vendors)



5. YOUR ORIGINAL EXAMINATION RESULT SLIP AND CCA CERTIFICATE

· Bring these documents if you have self-declared this information during application



6. YOUR MEDICAL REPORT

 If you are enrolled in a course requiring medical examination (see final page for list of courses)



7. (FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ONLY) STUDENT PASS OR VALID IMMIGRATION PASS

 Bring your Student Pass issued by the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) for study in ITE or valid immigration pass (e.g. dependent's pass /long-term visit pass)

4. COLOUR VISION TEST (CVT)

 Applicants registering for courses that require them to be free from colour appreciation deficiency will need to take a Colour Vision Test at the College. You can do a self-test at https://colormax.org/color-blind-test/ (see final page for list of courses)



5. NATIONAL SERVICE (NS) DEFERMENT

- NS-liable males will be granted NS deferment for the pursuit of full-time studies at pre-university government-funded institutions including ITE if they attain a place and are pursuing a course for higher academic qualifications from what they have previously attained (e.g. from N/O Levels to Nitec/Higher Nitec or from Nitec to Higher Nitec)
- NS deferment will no longer be subject to cut-off ages

- Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled in.

6. APPEAL FOR TRANSFER

- Accept your original course offer first before submitting an appeal
- Submit appeal for transfer online via the ITE website, or at the College





COURSES WITH COLOUR VISION TEST

Applicants enrolled in the following courses will need to take a colour vision test.

- Higher Nitec in Applied Food Science (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Chemical Process Technology (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Electrical Engineering (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Electronics Engineering (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Facilities Management & Engineering (3 years)
- Nitec in Aerospace Avionics
- Nitec in Aerospace Technology
- · Nitec in Mechatronics & Robotics

COURSES REQUIRING MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Applicants enrolled in the following courses with medical examination, are required to submit the medical report.

- Higher Nitec in Community Care & Social Services (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Culinary Arts (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Hospitality Operations (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Nursing (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Pastry & Baking (3 years)
- Higher Nitec in Sport Management (3 years)
