# 4. COLOUR VISION TEST (CVT)

# 5. NATIONAL SERVICE (NS) DEFERMENT

- NS-liable males will be granted NS deferment for the pursuit of full-time studies at pre-university government-funded institutions including ITE if they attain a place and are pursuing a course for higher academic qualifications from what they have previously attained (e.g. from N/O Levels to *Nitec/Higher Nitec* or from *Nitec* to *Higher Nitec*)
- · NS deferment will no longer be subject to cut-off ages

- Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled in.
