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## ITE Celebrates Outstanding Graduates from Class of 2024

ITE honoured the accomplishments of the Class of 2024 at its annual Graduation Ceremony. A total of 11,964 students graduated in Academic Year 2023/2024. Among the graduates, 604 were awarded the Diploma with Merit or Certificate of Merit for excelling as the top graduates of their cohort. Additionally, 222 Course Medals were presented to those who topped their respective courses.

The ceremony also saw the presentation of 10 Tay Eng Soon Scholarships to support deserving students in their educational journey, and Outstanding Progress Awards to 15 other graduates in recognition of their perseverance in overcoming challenges to complete their course.

The number of ITE graduates receiving Lifelong Learning Scholarships doubled this year, with 10 receiving the Tan Kah Kee Foundation Scholarship and another 10 awarded the Ng Teng Yeng Scholarship. 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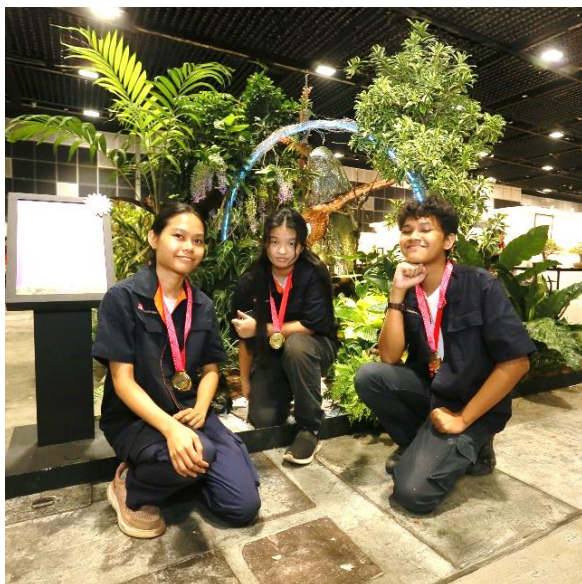


## Double Victory for ITE in Landscape Design Challenge
