After ITE




Dan Lin is pursuing a Diploma in Banking and Finance at Singapore Polytechnic. She aspires to take a Fintech-related degree in university.

After ITE



After ITE


Winnie will be representing Singapore in Information Network Cabling at the WorldSkills Competition 2024 in Lyon, France. She is planning to further her studies in 2025.

After ITE





After ITE


Chin Boon plans to learn more about AI and is considering to take a WSDip course focused on AI.
