More than 1,000 youths from 56 countries competed at the WorldSkills Competition 2022 Special Edition, which was hosted across 15 countries over a twelve-week period from September to November 2022. The competition was held in place of the cancelled WorldSkills Shanghai 2022.

To train students in the latest electronics manufacturing technologies, a revamped microelectronics training facility has been established at ITE College Central. The Microelectronics Training Centre now features machinery that integrates technologies such as Internet of Things and robotics.

The facility was launched at the Electronics Industry Seminar on 28 October 2022, by Mr Desmond Tan, Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office.

Organised by ITE and e2i (Employment and Employability Institute), the event featured industry speakers and a career fair for students.

At the event, ITE also renewed partnership agreements with STMicroelectronics and Systems on Silicon Manufacturing Company to expand training and employment opportunities for students.

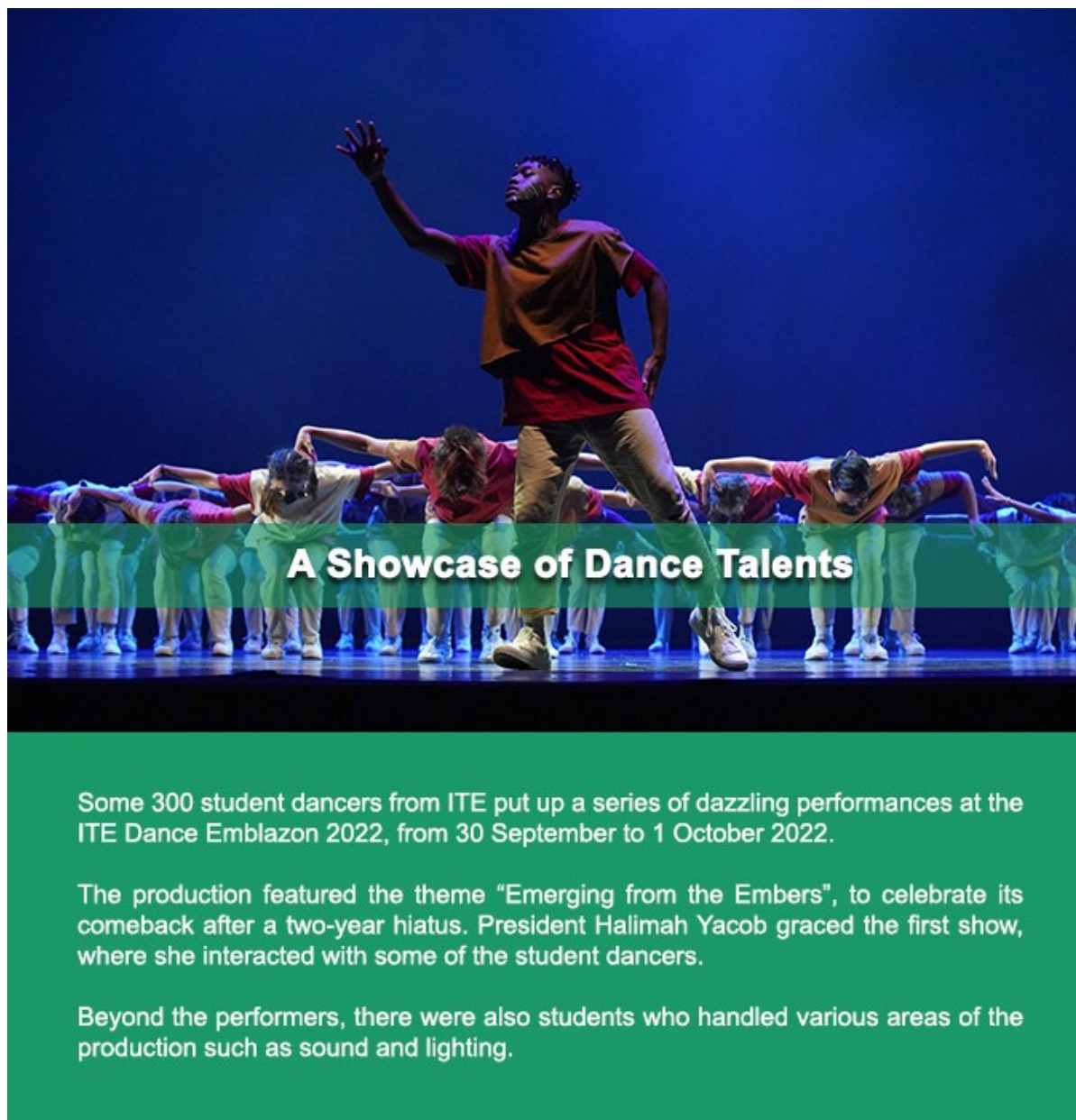
Nurturing Young Hawkers
