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## Honouring Work-Study Diploma Graduates from Class of 2024

ITE celebrated the accomplishments of the Class of 2024 at the annual ITE Work-Study Diploma (WSDip) Graduation Ceremony, recognising 749 graduates who successfully completed their WSDip journey. Among them, 37 were awarded Course Medals for their outstanding performance as top graduates in their respective courses.

Guest-of-Honour, Dr Mohamad Maliki bin Osman, Second Minister for Education, presented Course Medals to 19 recipients during the morning session of the two-part ceremony held on 24 Oct. In his address, Dr Maliki highlighted the success of ITE's WSDip programme, sharing that over 90% of 2023 graduates secured full-time employment within six months, with a median salary on par with polytechnic diploma holders.

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## More ITE Diploma Courses

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Starting in 2025, ITE will offer three new WSDips in [Community Care Integration & Management](#), [Human Resource Management](#), and [Paramedicine](#); along with two new Technical Diplomas in [Electrical Engineering \(Clean Energy\)](#) and [Health & Exercise Coaching](#).

ITE will also introduce two new WSDip specialisations – [Cabin Services](#) under the [WSDip in Customer Experience Management](#) and [Operations Management](#) under the [WSDip in Land Transport Engineering](#).

With these additions, ITE will offer 53 Diploma courses from 2025.

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## Paving Inclusive Pathways

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ITE launched the Enabling Pathway Programme (EPP) in collaboration with SG Enable, SIM People Development Fund, and SBS Transit on 3 Sep.

Officially inaugurated by Mr Chee Hong Tat, Minister for Transport, the EPP supports students with disabilities in engineering fields through hands-on internships and potential sponsorships for the Work-Study Diploma, equipping them for careers in the high-growth land transport sector.

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## Empowering Green Talent with Sustainable Energy Association of Singapore

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ITE and the Sustainable Energy Association of Singapore have teamed up to boost the renewable energy workforce. The signing of the Memorandum of Understanding was witnessed by Ms Low Yen Ling, Senior Minister of State for Trade and Industry.

Through this collaboration, trainers and supervisors will have access to industry certifications in solar panel installation, operation, and maintenance, equipping them with essential skills to drive green transformation.

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## Strengthening Culinary Excellence with Institute Lyfe
